GARDEN PARK SWIMMING POOL RULES

The pool and pool area are for the use of residents and their invited guests between 8:00am and 10:00pm daily. Access to the pool requires your pool key. Pool keys are the responsibility of condo owners. If you are a tenant, you must get the key from your owner. If your pool key is lost, please contact TPM for a replacement (\$50.00 non-refundable charge). Please sign in when you first arrive at the pool.

NO lifeguard is on duty at the pool. Swim at your own risk and be responsible for your guests.

- 1. Management fees must be current to be eligible to use the pool.
- 2. An adult **MUST** accompany all children under 14 years of age.
- 3. Residents aged 14-18 may have 3 guests only, without an accompanying adult.
- 4. Avoid rough play, running and splashing.
- 5. **No food or glass** of any kind is allowed in the pool area (plastic or aluminum drink containers are okay).
- 6. **No alcohol** is permitted in any container.
- 7. Bathroom facilities are in the basement and access is through the patio door only. Please dry off enough before going inside so that you do not leave slippery, wet floors.
- 8. Wet swimming suits are not permitted in the lounge area of the clubhouse.
- 9. Please keep volume of music and voices down.

- 10. Babies **MUST** wear "swim diapers" in the pool.
- 11. Remove suntan oil before entering the pool to avoid damage to the pump.
- 12. No smoking is permitted in the pool area.
- 13. Do not use your key to open the gate for anyone else. Always close the gate securely behind you when entering or leaving.
- 14. Please do not use the pool if you are ill or have been ill during the previous week.
- 15. Residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Make sure they understand the rules before they come to the pool.
- 16. There is no reserving of the pool for private parties.
- 17. If you see anyone in the pool after 10:00 pm, you may ask them to leave. If they do not comply, you may call the police and report trespassing. You need not identify yourself to the police when you call.

Garden Park Management Committee reserves the right to refuse access to the pool to residents or their guests who violate the rules.
