### Parking Pass Replacement

If your parking pass holder or passes have been damaged by the sun you may exchange them for free at the TPM office.

Parking passes must be visible (rear-view mirror area) at all times when parked on Arlington Drive or in common exterior guest parking. Lost or stolen passes can be replaced at a cost of \$150 each.

### Garbage Cans Must Be Stored Inside Garages:

Other than trash pick-up day, all garbage cans must be stored inside the garages. Trash cans stored outside garages are subject to fines.

## NOISE

As written in the Arlington Place Declaration of Covenants and Conditions; "No Obnoxious, destructive, or offensive activities shall be carried on within any lot or in any unit or in the common areas or any part thereof, nor shall anything be done there which may be or may become an annoyance or nuisance to any other owner or to any person at any time lawfully residing in the project."

We are in a community where neighbors live very close to one another and have very different sleep and work schedules. At no time may residents make noise that can be heard outside their private living quarters, this includes noise on streets or grounds at any hour. Every resident has the right to undisturbed study or sleep at any hour of the day or night. Games or social gatherings of any kind are prohibited in the Arlington common areas and streets 24/7. Please be courteous and considerate of others at all times.

FINES: Parties, gatherings, or disturbances that create noise that can be heard outside the townhome will result in a fine to the owner of up to \$1,500 from the Homeowners Association. In addition if the police are called to the scene to disband or establish quiet an additional fine of \$250 per police visit will be assessed to the owner. All such fines are due and payable immediately.

## Cleaning Up After Pets

We want to remind all Arlington residents to clean up after their pets. Dog feces and urine are damaging the lawns. Please clean up after your pets. The cost of clean-up, grass replacement, and fines will be charged to those not cleaning up after their pets.
