- Ted shared that Dorothy will send out the dripper system waivers electronically to all homeowners.

Ted and Jerry agreed to take calls on water issues, which is an ongoing problem, but repairs will be given to Leo to take care of.

- Steve Bunker was nominated as treasurer, it was seconded and passed.
- Dorothy Bryson was nominated as secretary, it was seconded and passed.
- Ted Jackman was nominated as a vice president, it was seconded and passed.
- Jerry Kite was nominated as a vice president, it was seconded and passed.
- Laureen Curtis will continue to serve as scribe to the board.
